Santa Lucia Campsite

Is there a tent suitable for me?

All 2 person standard tents are equipped with a mattress and a mattress cover. It is advised to bring a sleeping bag, pillow or cushion and torch.

If you want you can upgrade to a comfort family tent. Comfort tents are furnished with a double bed, a table, 4 chairs, open shelving and electric lighting. Please note that the comfort tents are only available on request.

Are there any facilities close to the campsite?

The campsite is close by to the fishing village with welcoming bars and restaurants. The campsite is located only 5 minute walks from the white sandy beach of Santa Lucia.

What type of meals is served?

As the resort is all inclusive there are no extra costs, guests can enjoy the international tone. Food is typically Italian, Sardinian wine, salad and fruits are served. Inclusive drinks include the drinks with the meals : coffee, tea and milk at breakfast, soft drinks & water at lunchtime, wine & water at diner. The drinks also includes a free beer, glass of wine or soft drink at the Happy Hour. Special diets can be requested.

Are there any other activities to do other than watersports?

Yes, there are many. Campers can opt to join walking excursions which allow you to walk past traditional villages, churches and historic places. A different walk is organised every second morning. Mountain bike tours can also be booked.

Where is the nearest cash dispenser?

The nearest cash dispenser is in La Caletta which is 5 km away. Please take into consideration that cash machines are often empty during peak season.

What must I take with me in addition to my normal luggage?

You must take with you a sleeping bag, pillow, torch, surf shoes, hand towels, beach towels, slippers, hat/sun visor, sun cream, sun glasses, insect repellent, summer clothes, sweater, toiletries and a first-aid kit.

Is there electricity in the tent?

There is electricity in the comfort tents, but not in the standard tents. However there are sockets at the camp reception where all electrics can be used, and also at the sink units where electric shavers / hairdryers etc can be used.
